-  **Abnormal swellings that persist or continue to grow**
-  **Sores that do not heal**
-  **Weight loss**
-  **Loss of appetite**
-  **Bleeding or discharge from any body opening**
-  **Offensive odor**
-  **Difficulty eating or swallowing**
-  **Hesitation to exercise or loss of stamina**
-  **Persistent lameness or stiffness**
-  **Difficulty breathing, urinating or defecating**
